

To prevent clogging, you might want to avoid flushing the following items in the toilet.

## **Baby Wipes**

Unlike toilet paper, baby wipes won't flush. They are heavy and tend to glob together inside the drain, building up over time.

# Diapers

Together with baby wipes, this is one of the most common reasons why you might need fixing a clogged toilet. Diapers don't biodegrade and just one item might be enough to cause a clog

#### **Cotton Pads**

These also do not break down. Cotton pads would snag other debris trying to flow past it, creating a blockage.

### **Dental Floss**

At first sight, this item might seem very unlikely to cause clogging. Yet a floss might easily turn into a net, trapping anything else coming after it.

## **Paper Towels**

They create blockages because they're made of a tougher blend of fibers. When you want to get rid of any toys, souvenirs or other items that are made of similar fibers, please throw them away together with dry garbage.
